Accommodation at Gluepot:

Although accommodation is available at Waikerie, it is 64km away (1 1/4 hours travel) so we suggest you camp at the Reserve as your best option. There are three camping grounds to choose from and you will need to be fully self-sufficient in regard to your camping equipment, water and food supplies. The camping grounds provide well-spaced sites that are suitable tents, caravans and vehicles. Toilets are provided at each camping ground but power is not available. The Reserve has an excellent, well maintained track system suitable for 2 WD vehicles and mountain bikes. Course fees include camping fees.



DIRECTIONS TO GLUEPOT RESERVE

1. TURN LEFT OUT OF SHELL SERVICE STATION.
2. TAKE FIRST TURN RIGHT TO FERRY.
3. AFTER FERRY CROSSING, FOLLOW BITUMEN ROAD TO MORGAN/RENMARK ROAD — 11 KM.
4. TURN LEFT AND TRAVEL 3 KM TO CHRISTADELPHIAN CHURCH ON RIGHT - LUNN ROAD.
5. TRAVEL 1.5 KM DOWN GRAVEL ROAD TO FIRST GATE.
6. FOLLOW SIGNS TO GLUEPOT.



What you will need to bring to the course:

- **Watercolour paper:** We will do small paintings so huge sheets are not needed, but heavy paper is definitely an advantage. 6 to 8 sheets A4 size about 300gsm in thickness is best. Or you may try a watercolour block or pad but buy the thickest paper you can. (Try a bargain shop for a beginner)
- **Palette:** A white plate or supermarket tray or bargain shop palette are good palettes.
- Paints Bring whatever you have in the way of paints. If you need to buy some, a small set of Watercolours is often the cheapest, or buy a limited palette eg a Red, blue, yellow, black. Paints can be in tubes or pans.
- If you have no acrylics, then a Paynes Grey is most useful.
- If you have no gouache, then a tube of white is most useful.
- Any brand of paint is suitable to try (try a bargain shop for a beginner)
- **Watercontainer:** Any jar

The Workshop



Bring nature to life in front of your eyes. If you have ever had the desire to paint or draw our wonderful birds, animals, plants or insects, then this is the course for you. We will talk about wildlife illustration, and what you as individuals would like to achieve. We may collect items from close to camp or you could

bring interesting photos, plants, rocks or wood pieces with you. I will supply some reference books and ideas as well. The workshop is open to all students regardless of their painting experience.

What you will learn

A variety of techniques using watercolour, gouache, acrylic pen and pencil will be explored. By the end of this workshop you will have found a style that suits you and let you progress into satisfying illustrations of nature. Because of the detailed work in much of this style of illustration, as many demonstrations as possible will be given, but with plenty of individual help for students to develop your own style of painting.

About Gluepot

Gluepot Reserve is a 54,000ha conservation reserve situated 64km north of Waikerie in South Australia's Riverland district. Gluepot was purchased by Birds Australia with the aim of "effectively managing a large, internationally significant area for biodiversity conservation". Among the 18 nationally threatened bird species resident on Gluepot are Black-eared Miner, Redlored Whistler, Regent Parrot, Striated Grasswren, Major Mitchell Cockatoo and Malleefowl, that are only a small section of the 190 bird species recorded there so far. There are few areas of the world that support such a concentration of threatened species.
